

Summary

- In the Leuphana semester a total of 5 modules have to be taken,
 3 interdisciplinary and 2 discipline-specific
- Registration for the courses is done via myStudy
- The course registration on myStudy does not automatically include the registration for the examination — this must be done via <u>myCampus</u> (<u>Guide for myCampus</u>)
- The official basis for the creation of the schedule is Appendix 5
- The appendix offers a clear list of all courses and examination forms to be taken
- The assignment to the myStudy courses takes place in two lotteries. At the end of the second lottery, all remaining places will be released for immediate registration.
